Who: Chris Cornell (Vocals) (from soundgarden), Tom Morello (Lead Guitar), Brad Wilk (Drums) and Tim Commerford (Bass) (all of which except for Chris where in Rage Against The Machine).

Repertoire: "Your Time Has Come", "Drown Me Slowly", "Doesn't Remind Me", "Rusty Cage", "Spoon-man" (2 Soundgarden covers), "Like A Stone", "Set It Off", "Bulls On Parade", "Sleep Now In The Fire" (2 Rage Covers), "Be Yourself", "Black Hole Sun" (Soundgarden), "Getaway Car", "Killing In The Name Of" (Rage), "Coshise", "Show Me How To Live" "I am The Highway"

Positive: This concert was amazing from start to finish. Chris Cornell has an amazing voice and he didn't miss a note. I especially liked Tom Morello's guitar playing because he is the most unique guitar player I have ever heard. He actually re-wired his guitar so it is different from anyone else's. With this re-wired guitar he can scratch like a DJ and it sounds wicked. I am a huge Rage Against The Machine fan so my favourite part of the show was when they played Rage covers.

Negative: I wasn't very impressed with the drumming. It was good but it was nothing special. Also they didn't have very good transition from one song to another. But other than that it was a really good show.
